

In 1993 the Municipality of Thessaloniki founded the Professional School of Dance which offers to the students an official Diploma from the State and Ministry of Culture as Dance Professors.

It is an Academy of three years of studies . In order to enter the School the students must necessarily have the Highschool Degree which means that they have to be over 18 years old . A committee from the Ministry of Culture exam the dancers that want to attend the school in the following classes: Classical Ballet, Contemporary Dance, Improvisation and Written Composition.

During the three years of studies which are divided in 6 semesters, most of the classes that have to be attended are obligatory. The lessons that are taught during the semesters are:

- Classical Ballet
- Contemporary Dance
- Theory of Ballet
- Theory of contemporary dance
- History of Dance
- Physiology
- Anatomy
- Music
- Character Dance
- Folk Dance
- Eurythmics
- Improvisation

If the school approves the progress of the students and the years of their attendance have been completed, the Committee of the State decides after the final exams if they can take their diploma.

Objective of the Superior Professional School of Dance is the complete and substantial dancing education of the students as well as their graduation of an academy of professors of dance with superior and reliable studies.
